



FAQs

- Does the SMS save to patient record?
 - Yes, Chain SMS automatically links to the currently open EMIS patient
 - Retrieves their SMS consent code, phone number and then saves the SMS to their record
- Why is it free?
 - accuRx want to help as many practices as possible to increase their efficiency. This will also allow them to offer their future products to more practices
- Will it always be free?
 - There will always be a free tier but we are developing a premium (paid) tier with new features for high-volume users
- Can patients reply to the message?
 - Chain SMS does not currently support this to avoid increasing practice workload
- Is it IG compliant?

 - IG Toolkit Level 2 assurance (NHS ODS code 8JT17)
